**AEMH's Position  
on the structure of the future collaboration of the  
European Medical Associations**

After the last AEMH-Board meeting and having taken advice from the Members, the AEMH thinks that the "Co-operation model" is currently the most appropriate structure to adopt.

The advantage is that it allows reaching the common aims

- to speak with one voice
- to avoid duplication of work
- to approach a Domus Medica (common office)

without change of statutes neither for the CPME nor for the Associated Organisations and allows to respect the specificity of each organisation.

If this co-operation model is crowned with success then we can in a second step approach one single **European Medical Organisation**, but this is in the current situation not realistic.
