6.1 Proposed Format for a Meeting in June 2009 between CPME and its AOs by UEMO: follow up CPME 2006/127 REV1 EN

The meeting has been scheduled for **11-13 June 2009 in Brussels** with the following programme proposal:

Thursday afternoon: different Board or Executive meetings of the EMOs and the Presidents Committee followed by a common dinner of the Presidents/Executives.

Friday: Parallel working group sessions in common; the topics of these working group sessions will be defined in a task force group in order to fit the activities of 2009. Hereafter follows a common dinner for all participants, for which a contribution will be requested.

Saturday: there will be a common meeting starting with an Academic Session demonstrating the activities of the European Medical Organisations in order to give this joint meeting an internal and external interest.

It is proposed to invite political speakers for the Academic Session, given the fact that the meeting will be held in Brussels. Dr Lies proposes to also invite nonmedical experts i.e. hospital managers.

Dr Mart points out that the most important aim of this joint meeting is to demonstrate that the EMOs are acting together.

SG Tiddens-Engwirda requests all EMOs to send in the names of the representatives for the Task Force (one person per EMO), which will run from November 2007. The Task Force will propose the subjects of the Working Groups and the Academic Session. The proposals will be reported back in writing by SG Tiddens-Engwirda to the Presidents' Committee.

Suggestions regarding the name of the meeting: "Joint Meeting of the EMOs", "First (Brussels) Meeting of European Doctors – jointly organised by the EMOs (list of EMOs)". These suggestions will also be forwarded to the Task Force.
