## RESOLUTION

During the plenary meeting held in Madrid on 24<sup>th</sup> of April 2004, after the written proposal submitted by the Greek Delegation, the A.E.M.H. General Assembly has considered it impossible to stay passive towards the consequences of the often brutal expression of violence, seen in national or international conflicts.

Therefore, the A.E.M.H. deeply deplores and disapproves of such violent manifestations causing major physical as well as mental effects on civilians, even deaths.

The A.E.M.H. physicians, united in front of such a dramatic emergency, remind all parties that they must care for all human beings whatever their nationality, faith or religious creed.
