Slovenia 2011 report

Ljubljana, 25th May 2011

Health care reform is currently going on, but the radical proposals of fundamental health care legislation from 2010 were much smoothened and the Minister of health was changed. Incentives of the reform are as follows:

- Reinforcement of public health care
- } Encourage medical professionals in managing health care institutions
- Shortening of waiting lists, enhance the health programs, where waiting periods are critical
- Acreditation of health care institutins

In October 2010 Domus medica Sloveniae was finished and Slovenian medical associations (Chamber, Association, Union) moved to the same building, where also educational facilities for CME activities are available.

Primary health was reinforced by additional funding and involvement of registered nurses helping in preventive medicine and uncomplicated chronic patients management.

A law on recognition of professional qualification of doctors from non EU countries was adopted.

First two hospitals succeeded to get an international accreditation certificate.

There is an initiative to divide Medical chamber to two chambers: medical and dentists.
