## The AEMH Secretariat / European Liaison Office

### Past

#### 1990

Establishment of the AEMH European Secretariat in Düsseldorf/ Germany, hosted and financial supported by the VLK, German Association of Senior Hospital Physicicans, one of the founder members of the AEMH, in Düsseldorf/ Germany. Recruitment of secretary (general) Alexandra Khazza.

#### 2001

Move of the office to Brussels on invitation of the CPME to rent office space within their premises. The financial support from the VLK decreases progressively. Recruitment of Brigitte Jencik.

#### 2003

End of the financial support from the VLK. In January 2003 the AEMH becomes a non-profit organisation under Belgian law.

#### 2005

In July start of collaboration with FEMS, provision of secretarial services and sharing of office space, with financial contribution paid to AEMH.

#### 2010

Brigitte Jencik goes self-employed (end of employer's taxes), and the AEMH Liaison Office goes "virtual". Secretarial services paid by FEMS directly to BJ, office space and office facilities paid to AEMH.

### Present

#### 2013

From May on, in view of the approaching retirement of Brigitte Jencik, split of the activity into secretariat and lobbying. Recruitment of a self-employed Brussels based European Policy Advisor, Catherine Hartmann. The administrative activities continue to be performed by BJ from a "virtual office".

### Future

#### 2014

Retirement of Brigitte Jencik, recruitment of a new secretary.
