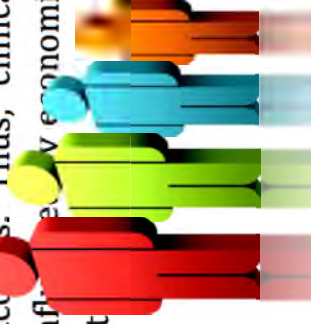

## **PART 2 – ON CLINICAL LEADERSHIP**
